Students,

Next week we will be disbursing the Emergency Relief funding. Your eligibility for this funding is based on the "need" of the student. The "Need" of the student is based on what the students expected family contribution is (as determined by completing a fafsa application) and how many credits the student is enrolled in. There are different amounts that are awarded based on your need (as the student). The amount that you will receive is based on the number of credits you are currently enrolled in and your expected family contribution. High school students and non-degree students are eligible to receive this disbursement.

The Grade incentive disbursement is awarded to all students (including dual credit and non-degree students) who make the Presidents List (4.00 semester grade point average), the Dean's List (3.50 gpa to 3.99 gpa), and the Honor Roll (3.00 gpa - 3.49 gpa). The grade incentive disbursement also provides incentives to students who have a semester grade point average of a 2.00 gpa to a 2.49 gpa, and also a 2.50 gpa to 2.99 gpa. The dollar amount varies for all of these categories. This grade incentive is also based on how many credits the students complete. High school students and non-degree students are eligible to receive this disbursement. This funding is awarded at the end of the semester once all of the grades have been determined.
