**Summary of Position:** The Research Center Coordinator will assist in the day-to-day logistical and operational tasks for research projects at Turtle Mountain College (TMC). The Research Coordinator will interact with investigators, collaborators, and students in a research environment. This person will coordinate and administer research study associated activities of faculty, students, and collaborators at TMC. The Coordinator will assist in project planning, and ensure that pre-established work scope, study protocol and regulatory requirements are followed and that full, secure recordkeeping systems and procedures are maintained.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Training in research for faculty.
- Maintain current working knowledge of all assigned protocols and reporting requirements.
- Adhere to all protocol requirements to ensure validity of research data.
- Recruit faculty and students to conduct research at TMCC.
- Enter data into computer databases.
- Maintain paper and computerized research files.
- Participate in research group meetings: schedule meetings; create agendas; complete minutes.
- Prepare mandatory reports and documents/protocols.
- Prepare for and participate in audits and monitoring of studies.
- Assist in preparation and maintenance of IRB protocols and related documents.
- Design, plan, and implement research projects
- Collect and analyze data
- Develop and implement data-collection instruments
- Monitor progress of research projects
- Prepare reports and presentations
- Develop and maintain relationships with research stakeholders
- Support grant application preparation in coordination with interested TMCC researchers
- Convey upcoming grant-funded research opportunities to internal constituents
- Ensure compliance with research protocols
- Manage research project budget and timelines
- Collaborate with other departments to ensure successful project completion
- Perform other duties as required.

- Experience in using statistical/data processing software (e.g., Excel, Excel Macro, SPSS and SPSS Syntax, Stata) and online survey technology (e.g., Qualtrics)
- High proficiency in all Microsoft Office suite applications is required, including in preparing and formatting data in written and graphic formats.
