### Challenges and What to do...

- 1. When you experience a personal, family, or medical problem during the semester
  - a. Discuss issues with your instructors
  - b. Meet with your advisor to discuss suggestions
  - c. Visit an advisor, the Retention Technician, or the Registrar to inquire about an "Incomplete "or "Withdrawal"
  - d. Visit Student Support Services Department located in the Student Union
- 2. If you are struggling in class
  - Are you attending class and then studying two hours per credit? Example: a 3 credit course = 6 hours of studying per week outside of class
  - b. Speak with your advisor and/or your instructors
  - c. Consider seeking a tutor
- 3. If you need help with reading, writing, or study skills
  - a. Contact your instructor
  - b. Visit Student Support Services for help
- 4. If you have learning disabilities
  - a. Visit Vocational Rehabilitation Center
  - b. Contact Student Support Services for assistance
- 5. Not sure if you are in the appropriate program
  - a. Visit an advisor and make the appropriate change with Admissions Office
  - b. Complete a TMCC Application-Update card to change your curriculum
- 6. When you are in classes with a large number of students
  - a. Sit toward the front of the room
  - b. Avoid others who may be distracting to you

- c. Resist missing class
- d. Form a small study group
- e. Ask the instructor for extra help or clarification when needed
- 7. If you are placed on Academic Probation

- a. When your GPA falls below a 2.0 you are in academic danger and will be placed on Academic Probation
- b. For more details visit with the Registrar's Office
- 8. If Financial Aid Probation or Suspension becomes an issue
  - You may be placed on probation or suspension if you drop below the credit level for which you were funded or did not meet the Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress
- 9. If you have Personal Counseling Issues
  - a. Free services are available for students through the IHS Counseling Center 477-8658
  - b. Contact Harmony Lindgren at TMCC Counseling Services – 477-7947
- 10. High School to College Transition
  - a. You are required to manage your own time and will not be monitored as closely as you have been in high school
  - b. More study time required (two hours per credit)
  - c. Form study groups
  - d. Use a daily planner to keep on track

e. Pay attention to your course syllabus to maintain progress in class

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Q. Where do I go to get a Jenzabar password?

A. Locate the IT Department on the second floor in room A207. See Quenna Beston.

#### Q. How do I register for courses?

A. Log into Jenzabar, select the "online registration" tab, and then on the right hand of the screen, select "add/drop courses". You may adjust your schedule in this area. When finished selecting courses, you would select "send to advisor" at the bottom of the page and wait for your advisors approval.

# Q. How can I get a copy of my unofficial transcript or schedule?

A. Log into Jenzabar, select the "student tab", then in the left hand column, select "unofficial transcript" or select "my schedule". You may print them both from this area.

#### Q. How do I get a replacement ID card?

A. You can get a replacement ID card by printing a copy of your class schedule, then by locating the Business Office on the first floor in room 118 to pay \$2 for the replacement ID card, and then locate the Security Officer on the first floor. The Security Officer will take your class schedule and your receipt and print a replacement student ID for you.

#### Q. How will I know if the College is closed?

A. The Alert Now System will send out an automated message informing all students of any cancellations, or important messages. Please be sure to keep your phone numbers current with the Student Services Department for this purpose.



#### Q. How do I drop a class?

A. You can drop a class by going to the Student Services Department, picking up the add/drop card, it needs to be filled out completely with all of the required signatures, and return the card to the Student Services Department.

#### Q. How do I change my degree program?

A. You can change your degree program (curriculum) by going to the Student Services Department, picking up the TMCC Application – Update card (gold card), it needs to be filled out completely with accurate information. Once completed, return the card to Joni LaFontaine in Students Services.


